10	All rights, including but not limited to any fishing or navigation rights, existing over that section of the River Liffey party traversing the Townlands of Celbridge Abbey in the District Electoral Division of Celbridge and Donaghmore and the County of Kildare and between the green line A21 and A22, running for a distance of approximately 120.00 metres and shown on Drawing No. 80/1083 APS, 88-89 D&S 2000/01 of the Deposited Maps.
