

The post Order will also authorize the Local Authority to relinquish the police rights and the private rights, as they described in Part 1 and Part 2 respectively, of the Schedule in the said Order. It is requested that you inform what they have acquired the land where the said public rights, and Private rights of any of you are over the land as acquired in any part thereof of your said rights or as associated with the land as acquired in any part thereof.

(b) An inheritance tax is payable in respect of the land if an objection is made in respect of the acquisition by an owner, lessee, or mortgagee of the land, and not otherwise.

(c) An order which authorises the extinguishment of a public right of way does not extinguish any right of way if there is an alteration in the neighbourhood, which is of substantial benefit to the land.

An Acquisition (Rights) can be absolute situation under Section 215 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) and it is not binding.

Before making its decision on an application to acquire the Compulsory Purchase Order, the Commission must consider any objection made and set forth, in the Commission's determination, the reasons for its decision.

Section 217A of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended), sets out the right of appeal who have the right to appeal, and the hearing takes place in the Commission.

The Commission, if it finds it, may confirm the compulsory acquisition as set out, or it may, with or without conditions or modifications, to the point the compulsory acquisition or any part thereof.

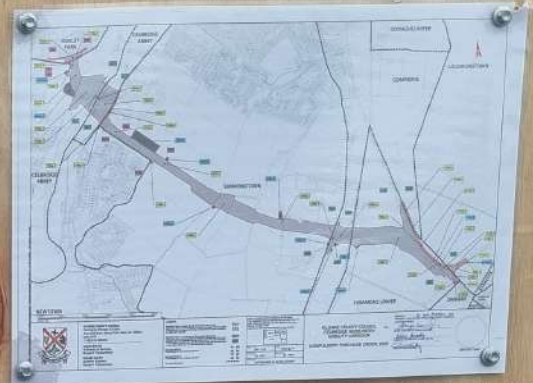
