







Fin cycle stand, three racks laid out against the slope parallel to the road, in grade 316L stainless steel, 50mm dia. tube 2mm wall thickness allows two bicycles per rack. Cast in to 350mm depth, with selected natural limestone 200x100 mm cobble surface to generate a differently textured surface from the surrounding. Stock proof fencing posts to be reinstated above the wall and fresh 1" stock proof mesh installed to the rear of the posts with a woven hazel/willow panels 1.2m ht. secured to the front

Holly, <u>Ilex aquifolium</u> an appropriate hedge infill with good wildlife properties. Medieval medicinal plants to replace laurel and others in the stone planter, chosen for the theme and pollinator properties. The plant material to be arranged according to a detailed planting plan. Examples of medicinal medieval plants include; Lemon balm <u>Melissa officinalis</u> counter sunk in a baseless container <u>Mentha suaveolens</u>, monks herb, similarly countersunk, also for <u>Mentha piperita</u> peppermint, Oreganum vulgare Oregano <u>Oreganum majorana</u>, Marjoram, <u>Thymus serphyllum</u> Wild thyme, <u>Thymus vulgaris</u>, Common thyme, <u>Symphytum officinale</u> Comfrey (bone set) planted countersunk, <u>Salvia officinalis</u>, Sage <u>Viola tricolour</u> Heartsease Pansy, <u>Digitalis sps.</u> Foxglove, <u>Anise pimpinella</u> anisum, Betony <u>Stachys officinalis</u>, Hyssop, <u>Hyssopus officinalis</u>, Rue <u>Ruta graveolens</u>, Dill <u>Anthemum graveolens</u>, Cumin <u>Cuminum cyminum</u>, Cotton lavender <u>Santolina chamaecyparisssus</u>, Marigold <u>Callendula officinalis</u>, <u>Scutterleria gariculata</u> Skullcap.
