Under Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act 1994 Local Authorities are obliged to carry out a public consultation process and consult with An Garda Síochána with regard to implementing and enforcing traffic calming measures.


This proposal consist of 1no. New Bus Shelter and all associated works at Bus Stop 132491, Brownstown Manor, Brownstown, Co. Kildare was advertised in the Nationalist and the Leinster Leader, in the edition of 03rd February 2026. It was also placed on public display on Level 4 counter, Áras Chill Dara and on the council website. It was open for submissions for a period of four weeks from Tuesday 03rd February to Tuesday 02nd March 2026 with a closing date of 5.00pm on 02nd March 2026.

This proposal followed a review of existing bus stop infrastructure and will be funded under Kildare County Councils Bus Stop Enhancement Programme to allow for the procurement of contractors and progression of this scheme.

The proposed plans were forwarded to An Garda Síochána for comment. Confirmation was received on behalf of the Superintendent of Kildare South Community Engagement and they reported no objections to the proposed bus shelter at this location.

No submissions were received from the members of the public.

Recommendation that the proposal goes forward for noting at the Kildare Newbridge Municipal District meeting on 18th March 2026.
