Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 58 of the Planning and Development Act 2024 (as amended), that Kildare County Council has prepared modifications that constitute Proposed Material Alterations to Proposed Variation No. 6 (Sallins Settlement Plan) of the Kildare County Development Plan 2023-2029 (as varied).

In accordance with Section 58(13)(b) of the Planning and Development Act 2024 (as amended), it has been determined that a Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) is not required to be carried out in respect of the Proposed Material Alterations of the Proposed Variation. In accordance with Section 58(13)(c) of the Planning and Development Act 2024 (as amended), it has been determined that an Appropriate Assessment (AA) is not required to be carried out in respect of the Proposed Material Alterations of the Proposed Variation.

All submissions with respect to the Proposed Material Alterations to the Proposed Variation No. 6 (Sallins Settlement Plan) of the Kildare County Development Plan 2023-2029 (as varied) and associated documents shall be taken into account by the authority before the Variation of the Development Plan is made and will form part of the statutory Chief Executive's Report to be prepared for the Elected Members.

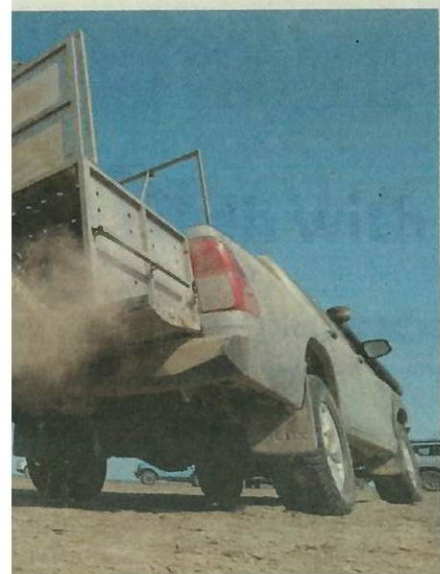
