EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

Notice is hereby given of the decision of Kildare County Council to extend the duration of the closure as detailed below of the following road in accordance with Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 and the Roads Regulations, 1994:

Phase	Road to be Closed	From (Junction with)	To (Junction with)
2A and 2B	R405 Hazelhatch Road, Celbridge	R405 Hazelhatch Road / R403 Dublin Road / Newton Road Junction, Celbridge	R405 / Shinkeen Road, Celbridge

Road closure extended to **Thursday, 31 August 2023**.
The closure is required to facilitate installation of pipework.
Alternative Routes:
Southbound vehicles on the R405 / R403 (Liffey Bridge) towards Newcastle will be diverted left at the R403 / R405 / Ardclough Road intersection and will continue east along the R403 (circa 0.5km). They will then divert right and continue along the Shinkeen Road (circa 0.5km). They will divert left and merge onto the R405 again.
Northbound vehicles on the R405 from Newcastle toward Celbridge will be diverted right at the Shinkeen Road Junction. They will continue along the Shinkeen Road (circa 0.5km). They will then divert left onto the R403 and right across the Liffey Bridge.
Any inconvenience caused is regretted.

**PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES
SECTION 38 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1994**

In accordance with the provisions of Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act 1994, Kildare County Council hereby gives notice of its intention of:
W6 Orbital Route Bus Stop Locations, Straffan Road, Maynooth and Maynooth Community College (Moyglare Hall Estate), Maynooth.
As part of the NTA's BusConnects programme a new orbital bus route is scheduled to commence in Q2 of 2023.
Orbital Routes:
These routes provide connections between suburbs and town centres, without having to travel into the City Centre. They also provide connections to rail, Luas and other bus routes. Enhanced orbital routes will provide major network connectivity benefits for customers and support the introduction of associated spine services.
Stop Locations:
As part of the new W6 orbital route connecting Tallaght to Maynooth via Celbridge of the BusConnects Network Redesign project, two new bus stops are proposed within Maynooth as follows.
One new bus stop is proposed on the Straffan Road, and one new bus stop is proposed beside Maynooth Community College (Moyglare Hall Estate). Please see maps identifying bus stop locations.

**TEMPORARY CLOSING OF ROADS
NOTICE OF DECISION
ROADS ACT, 1993
ROADS REGULATIONS, 1994**

Kildare County Council, on behalf of Kildare Newbridge Municipal District Office, gives notice in accordance with Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 and the Roads Regulations, 1994 that it will close the following roads during the period between **Tuesday, 4 April 2023 to Saturday, 30 September 2023** to facilitate the maintenance of the road network as per Section 13 of the Roads Act 1993.

Alternative Routes:
Northbound traffic will be directed in a westbound direction on Main Street, Newbridge (R445), towards the junction of the R445 / R416 / L7041 beside the Liffey Bridge. Traffic will be directed to turn left onto the L7041 Canning Place/Sex Road, then travel northbound towards the roundabout abutting Newbridge College. At the roundabout take the first exit staying on Sex Road (L7045) passing over Sex Bridge heading to the Roseberry Hill/Richardstown Roundabout, taking the first exit continuing on the L7045, travelling in a westbound direction passing Sarsfields GAA Club to Byrnes Cross (junction of the R416 / L7045 / L7036). At Byrnes Cross turn left and head southbound on the R416, finishing back at the T-junction of Station Road and Páirc Mhuire, Newbridge (R416 / L70691).
Southbound traffic will be directed off the R416 onto the L7045 passing Sarsfields GAA Club to the Roseberry Hill/Richardstown Roundabout, continuing on the L7045 by taking the second exit and travelling in a southbound direction, passing over Sex Bridge. At the roundabout abutting Newbridge College take the second exit on to the L7041, heading southbound to the junction of the R445 / R416 / L7041 (Canning Place / Main Street, Newbridge).
At the junction of Canning Place / Main Street, Newbridge turn right onto the R445 (Main Street) and finish at the junction of Station Road/Main Street and Edward Street, Newbridge.

Diversionary routes will be clearly signposted, as agreed with the Council and An Garda Síochána. Emergency access and restricted local access will be maintained.

Alternative Routes:
Northbound traffic shall be redirected to the R445 at McLoughlin's Cross towards Newbridge and redirected to the L70369 Moorefield Road. Traffic then will be directed to the L7037 Standhouse Road and finish at the junction of the L7036 Langton Road.
Southbound traffic shall be redirected to the L7037 Standhouse Road. Traffic will be directed along the L70369 Moorefield Road and redirected onto the R445 and finish at the junction of the L7036, McLoughlin's Cross.

Diversionary routes will be clearly signposted, as agreed with the Council and An Garda Síochána. Emergency access and restricted local access will be maintained.
