You must be a tenant of Kildare County Council to be eligible to apply and your rent account must be up to date.

The objective of this scheme is to assist Local Authority tenants to carry out improvement works on their home.

- The Tenant Support Scheme can be used to replace defective windows and doors, defective kitchen units, heating systems, or for other minor works.

Priority will be given to climate action improvements such as new glazing, insulation, heat pumps etc.

INCREASED COST OF BUSINESS (ICOB) GRANT

As part of Budget 2024, the Government introduced a package of €257m for the Increased Cost of Business (ICOB) Grant as a vital measure for small and medium businesses. Kildare County Council, funded through Department of Enterprise, Trade and Employment (DETE), will manage the rollout of the grant to qualifying businesses in Kildare.

Eligible businesses will receive a once-off grant payment, a contribution towards the rising costs faced by businesses. The amount of the grant payable to eligible businesses is based on the value of the Commercial Rates bill the business received in 2023.

Correspondence to businesses on how to register for the grant has now issued and the closing date for businesses to confirm eligibility and upload verification details will be Wednesday, 1 May 2024.

To qualify for the grant, businesses must be rates compliant, tax compliant and possess a valid Tax Registration Number (TRN). Details of the Increased Cost of Business (ICOB) Grant Rates:

- For qualifying businesses with a 2023 Commercial Rates bill of <€10,000, the ICOB grant will be paid at a rate of 50% of the business's Commercial Rates bill for 2023.
- For qualifying businesses with a 2023 Commercial Rates bill of between €10,000 and €30,000, the ICOB grant will be €5,000.
- Businesses with a 2023 Commercial Rates bill greater than €30,000 are not eligible to receive an ICOB grant.

PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES SECTION 38 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1994

In accordance with the provisions of Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act 1994, Kildare County Council hereby gives notice of its intention for:

Proposed Rapid Build Scheme to protect cycle infrastructure and vulnerable road users on the Shinkeen Road, Celbridge consisting of:

- Installation of cycle lane bollard and Kerb separators along carriageway.
- Installation of new bus platforms along carriageway.
- Additional protection provided at R403 Dublin Road junction and the R405 Hazelhatch Road junction.
- Additional protection provided at estate entrance junctions.
- Uncontrolled pedestrian points to be upgraded at identified estate entrance junctions; and
- Red thermoplastic surfacing to be reinstated at all junctions.
