De réir fhorálacha Alt 38 den Acht um Thrácht ar Bhóithre 1994, tugann Comhairle Contae Chill Dara a fógra rúin leis seo:

Gréasán Náisiúnta Raonta Rothar (GNRR) Ath-leithroinnt Spáis Bóithre Píolóta R448 Maoin go Tigh Moling a bhaineann le

- Scéim rothar píolóta a thógáil ar an R448.
- Ath-leithroinnt na nguailí crua atá ansin cheana féin feadh an R448 ó Mhain go Tigh Moling.
- Lánaí rothar aontreocha a shuiteáil laistigh do na guailí crua atá ansin cheana féin.
- Gnéithe éagsúla scartha carrbhealaigh/lána rothar a shuiteáil, lena n-áirítear scaradh modúlach, atá déanta le tírdhreachú agus marcáil bóthar.
- Cothabháil thairsí a shuiteáil ag gach taobh den scéim; ó thuaidh d'acomhal R747 agus ó dheas do bhealach amach R448, go Bunscóil Chaitliceach Cholm Cille.
- Trasrianta neamhrialaithe a shuiteáil sa cheantar timpeall ar acomhal R747, Ardán Thigh Moling, Bóthar Mhaoine, agus bealach amach R448 go Bunscóil Chaitliceach Cholm Cille.
- Laghdú i leithid na lána carrbhealaigh ar an R448 go 3.5m.
- Raon coirnéil a laghdú ag R747, Ardán Thigh Moling, Bóthar Mhaoine, agus bealach amach R448 go hacmhail Bhunscoil Chaitliceach Cholm Cille.
- Na lánaí atá ag casadh ar chlé, ag dul ó thuaidh agus ó dheas, ar an mbealach isteach go dtí acomhail an R747, a bhaint.
- Dromchla teirmeaplaisteach dearg a sholáthar laistigh do na lánaí rothar ag gach acomhal agus bealach isteach.
- Marcanna agus comharthaíocht carrbhealaigh agus rothar a sholáthar.

PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES
SECTION 38 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1994

In accordance with the provisions of Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act 1994, Kildare County Council hereby gives notice of its intention of:

National Cycle Network (NCN) Road Space Re-Allocation Pilot R448 Moone to Timolin comprising of:

- Construction of a pilot cycle scheme on the R448.
- Reallocation of the existing hard shoulders along the R448 from Moone to Timolin.
- Installation of uni-directional cycle lanes within the existing hard shoulders.
- Installation of varying cycle lane/carriageway segregation features, including landscaped, modular and road marking segregation.
- Installation of gateway treatments at either end of the scheme; north of the R747 junction and south of the R448 exit to St. Colmcilles Catholic National School.
- Installation of uncontrolled crossings in the vicinity of the R747 junction, Timolin Terrace, Moone Road and the R448 exit to St. Colmcilles Catholic National School.
- Reduction in R448 carriageway lane widths to 3.5m.
- Reduction in corner radii at the R747, Timolin Terrace, Moone Road and the R448 exit to St. Colmcilles Catholic National School junctions.
- Removal of the north and southbound left turn lanes on approach to the R747 junctions.
- Provision of red thermoplastic surfacing within the cycle lane at all junctions and accesses.
- Provision of carriageway and cycle markings and signage.

PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES
SECTION 38 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1994

In accordance with the provisions of Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act 1994, Kildare County Council hereby gives notice of its intention of:

St Brigid's Primary School, Kildare Town, Safe Routes to School Scheme comprising of:

- Traffic calming measures installed within the extent of works including tightening of junctions and raised crossings to reduce vehicular speeds and prioritise pedestrians.
- Various footpaths widened to promote safe active travel.
- Installation of bollard and pencil bollards within the designated school zones.
- New road markings and resurfacing works within the extents of work.
- New raised and level pedestrian crossings on Academy Street, Grey Abbey Road, Meadow Road, Tully Road and Bride Street.
- On-street parking on Academy Street and Grey Abbey Road reduced with additional accessibility parking spaces and regulated bus set down areas.
- Safe routes to school initiatives such as bollards, road markings and signage to be incorporated outside the school to enhance greater safety to vulnerable road users.
