**Proposed Construction of 1 No. New Bus Shelter at Stop 132991, Broadford,
Co. Kildare (West-bound).**

Under Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act 1994 Local Authorities are obliged to carry out a public consultation process and consult with An Garda Síochána with regard to implementing and enforcing traffic calming measures.

These proposals which consist of 1 No. New Bus Shelter at Stop 132991, Broadford, Co. Kildare was advertised in the Liffey Champion in the addition of 12th April and the Leinster Leader, in the edition of 15th April 2025. It was also placed on public display on Level 4 counter, Áras Chill Dara and on the council website. It was open for submissions for a period of four weeks from Tuesday 15th April to Friday 16th May 2025 with a closing date of 5.00pm on 16th May 2025

This proposal followed a review of existing bus stop infrastructure and will be funded under Kildare County Councils Bus Stop Enhancement Programme to allow for the procurement of contractors and progression of this scheme.

The proposed plans were forwarded to An Garda Síochána, Leixlip for comment. Confirmation was received from the Sergeant, An Garda Síochána, Leixlip, and they reported no objections to the proposed bus shelter at this location.

One submission was received from the members of the public.

Recommendation that the proposal goes forward for noting at the Clane/Maynooth Municipal District meeting on 06th June 2025.
