This road proposal was democratically defeated in 2019 by Naas councillors (6:1 votes) who are on the record in Naas MD Council minutes as stating this road proposal is outdated and not fit for purpose. It is entirely unacceptable to disregard this democratic decision and continue to attempt to include it county development plans, The proposed Gallops Ave road must be deleted from the county development plan.

The same route was proposed in 1992 which is some 30 years ago. It is a plan which is out of date for the current and foreseeable population in Naas. Population then was around 11000 in 1992 and now is ~ 20000. Population expectation will be near 25000 in the next 5 - 10 years and this route will not provide much traffic relief as it stands.
