

Family fun day at Curragh Races

A National Lottery player in Co. Kildare became Ireland's newest millionaire following Friday night's EuroMillions 'Ireland Only Raffle' draw.

It was the fourth and final draw of the special raffle which made four brand new millionaires in Ireland over the month of August.

The winning ticket worth €1

million was won by a player in Kildare who purchased their ticket online or through the National Lottery App.

Typically, in every single EuroMillions draw, ten players in Ireland win €5,000 on the 'Ireland Only Raffle'.

In Friday night's draw, an additional €1 million was added to the special raffle draw.

And among those ten winners of €5,000, one of those winners won an additional €1 million.
