

PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT 2000 (AS AMENDED) – PART XI

PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS 2001 (AS AMENDED) - PART 8

SITE LOCATION: ST. PATRICK'S PARK, RATHANGAN, CO. KILDARE, R51 E308

Proposed Development: Pursuant to the requirements of the above, notice is hereby given by Kildare County Council of a proposed social housing development and regeneration works at St. Patrick's Park, Rathangan, Co. Kildare.

The proposed development comprises of the demolition of 15 no. dwellings, refurbishment of 25 no. dwellings, construction of 7 no. dwellings and extensive site development works to create a new landscaped public open space. These works will consist of:

- Construction of 1 no. 4-bed 1-storey dwelling, 3 no. 3-bed 2-storey dwellings and 3 no. 2-bed single-storey dwellings.
- Refurbishment of 17 no. vacant units and 8 no. occupied units.
- Demolition of 15 no. units to allow the development of a new landscaped public open space.
- Removal of existing hardscaped play area and replacement with a new landscaped public open space and car parking.
- The provision of new car park area on Kildare County Council lands to the north-west.
- Proposed new gate access to adjacent Kildare County Council lands.
- The removal of existing back lane and extension of existing gardens to the rear of units 657 to 662.
- Associated site development and civil works; including works to existing site and dwelling
 boundaries, boundaries to new dwellings, drainage, utilities, public lighting, upgrade of paths
 and roads, new paths and roads and hard landscaping, ancillary site services and site development
 works above and below ground, extensive site development works to create new landscaped
 public open space.

This application also includes an Appropriate Assessment Screening report and an Environmental Impact Assessment Screening report.

The proposal has undergone Appropriate Assessment Screening under the Habitats Directive (92/43/ EEC), the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, and the European Communities (Bird and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 – 2015. Kildare County Council has determined that an Appropriate Assessment is not required. The proposed development will not have a significant effect on a European Site.

In addition, the proposal has also undergone screening for Environmental Impact Assessment under the EIA Directive 2011/92/EU as amended by Directive 2014/52/EU, (and the relevant provisions of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, and the Planning and Development Regulations 2001, as amended) and Kildare County Council has determined that there is no real likelihood of significant effects on the environment arising from the proposed development and that an Environmental Impact Assessment is not required.

In accordance with Article 120 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended), any person may, at any time before the expiration of 4 weeks beginning on Friday, 4 November 2022, apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination as to whether the proposed development would be likely to have significant effects on the environment.

NOTICE OF INTENTION ROADS ACT, 1993 ROADS REGULATIONS, 1994

Kildare County Council, on behalf of Irish Water, gives notice in accordance with Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 and the Roads Regulations, 1994 that it intends to close the following roads during the period commencing Tuesday, 22 November 2022 to Friday, 27 January 2023 to facilitate installation of pipework.

Alternative Routes:

Vehicles travelling Southwest will be redirected at Athgarvan Crossroads to the R416 to Kinneagh Cross. Traffic will then be redirected to R413 towards the Curragh to finish at the junction to the L2032.

Vehicles travelling Northeast will be redirected to the R413 towards Kinneagh Cross. Traffic will be directed at Kinneagh Cross to the R416 towards Athgarvan and finish at Athgarvan Crossroads.

Diversionary routes will be clearly signposted, as agreed with the Council and An Garda Siochána. Emergency access and restricted local access will be maintained.
