An Bord Pleanála has, on the 26th day of January 2024, made a confirmation order confirming (with modifications) the above-named compulsory purchase order as respects the land described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule hereto.

The said order, as so confirmed, authorises Kildare County Council to acquire the said land compulsorily. It will become operative three weeks from the date of publication of this notice.

No. 15 of 1986) may be made to the High Court within eight weeks of the date of publication of this notice in accordance with section 50 of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended.
